REQUIREMENTS to the preparation of abstracts

The volume of abstracts is up to 5 pages. Text editor - Microsoft Word. Page format - A4, all margins - 20 mm. Font - Times New Roman 14 point size, 1.5 spacing, paragraph - 12.5 mm.

Credits (right-justified):

– surname, initials - bold;

– academic degree, academic title, position and place of work - normal font.

Title of abstracts: bold font, all characters are uppercase, no hyphenation, center alignment.

Text part: justified alignment, no word wrap.

List of used literature: placed at the end of the text in order of reference, justified alignment, drawn up as a numbered list in accordance with the established requirements.
